  - o Zebra Mussels from McKenzie
- Do the fish have adequate habitat?
- Washing your dock for AIS?
- Boat landing is dangerous
  - Last time the township helped with fill
- Parking issues at boat landing
  - Vehicles and trailers are parked too close to the landing and make it difficult for other vessels to launch
- Power loading ordinance
  - o Recently enacted Burnett County law forbids power loading
  - Who provides signage?
  - o Association will update with info
- Over 70.5 age can make a qualified charitable distribution from their IRA if they don't meet requirements to itemize their taxes and therefore cannot deduct greater than the standard deduction
- Percentage of properties in the Natural Shoreline Preservation
- Percentage of properties on Des Moines Lake that our members of the association and what we can do to increase that?
  - o Approximately 55%
