Questions

- Do property owners need to decon even if their boat is only used in Des Moines Lake?
 - Yes. Burnett County ordinance requires boaters to decontaminate if a station is present at a boat landing
- Are we building the shed or is it pre-fab?
 - The quote was for a pre-fab shed from a company 45 minutes south of Webb Lake.
- What is AIS?
 - Aquatic Invasive Species are plants or animals that do not naturally occur in our waters and may cause harm to the environment
- What is turnkey?
 - A turnkey solution is one that is fully developed by a vendor and is ready to use.
- How many parcels on Des Moines Lake?
 - 117.
- How many members?
 - 66 in 2023
 - We are on track for 72 in 2024
- If the WDS is not approved what would be our decontamination method? Would we go back to bleach?
 - Yes
